 - (b) What does ‘a dream deferred’ mean in “Harlem,” a poem by Langston Hughes? Discuss in the context of the poem.
 - (c) Consider “Still I Rise” by Maya Angelou as a poem of protest.
 - (d) Show how Wilfred Owen explores the reality of war in “Dulce et Decorum Est”.
 - (e) What are the main ideas in the essay “Toys” by Roland Barthes?
2. Answer any **one** of the following questions: 5×1= 5
- (a) Write a brief note on the use of the expression ‘Dulce et Decorum Est’ by Wilfred Owen.
 - (b) Comment on any two symbols in the poem “Still I Rise” by Maya Angelou.
 - (c) What is the significance of the bus ride episode in Amitav Ghosh’s “The Ghosts of Mrs Gandhi”?
 - (d) What does Eunice De Souza mean by ‘formalities’ in the poem “Marriages Are Made”? What does she say about the arranged marriages in India?
 - (e) The poem “Harlem” is full of questions. Is it significant that there are no answers to these questions? Justify.
