(a) Critically evaluate Anne Bradstreet's feminist view point in the poem, "The Prologue".

OR

(b) How does India appeal to Walt Whitman in his poem, "A Passage to India"?

2. Locate and annotate any **one** of the following in about 200 words: 5×1 = 5

(a) "I've known rivers:
Ancient, dusky rivers."

(b) "For what is the present after all but a growth out of the past?"

SECTION-II

3. Answer any **one** of the following questions in about 500 words: 15×1 = 15

(a) Discuss the appropriateness of the title "Beloved" with reference to Morrison's novel.

OR

(b) How is Morrison's novel *Beloved* a tribute to the 'middle-passage'?

4. Answer any **three** short questions from the following in about 200 words each: 5×3 = 15

(a) Briefly comment on the role of fate in "The Ambitious Guest."

(b) Write a short note on the significant differences between the Old South and the New South in Faulkner's story, "Dry September".

(c) Do you consider Edgar Allan Poe's "The Purloined Letter" as a successful detective story? Justify in brief.

(d) Briefly illustrate the theme of disillusionment in F. Scott Fitzgerald's short story, "The Crack-Up".
