About the Workshop:

Goods and Services Tax (GST) is a

successor to VAT used in India on the

supply of goods and services. GST is a digitalized form of VAT where one can also track the goods & services. Both VAT & GST have the same taxation slabs. It is a comprehensive, multistage, destination-based tax: comprehensive because it has subsumed almost all the indirect taxes except a few state taxes. Multi-staged as it is, the GST is imposed at every step in the production process, but is meant to be refunded to all parties in the various stages of production other than the final consumer and as a destination-based tax, it is collected from point of consumption and not point of origin like previous taxes. The Workshop on GST organized by IQAC, Sarojini Naidu College for Women attempts to delve deep into the various issues related to this new taxation regime in India.
