Title of the Program: ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR ON "RESEARCH

PUBLICATIONS"

The IQAC of Sarojini Naidu College for Women, Dum Dum Kolkata, organized One Day

International Webinar on "Research Publications" on 31st August, 2020 via the Google Meet

platform and live streamed online on the College's official Youtube channel for the audience.

Objective: The objective of the webinar was to generate an awareness as to update various

stakeholders such as research fellows, students and faculty on the modern norms and ways of

research publications, since the way research is done and presented has also undergone

extensive transformation in recent times.

Content: The event was inaugurated by our respected principal madam- Dr. Urmila Ukil.

Our chief guest was Prof. Basab Chaudhuri, Vice Chancellor, West Bengal State University.

Our eminent speakers for the day were Dr. Sandeep Poddar, Senior Research Director,

Lincoln University College, Malaysia and Dr. Priyank Pravin Patel, Assistant Professor,

Department of Geography, Presidency University, Kolkata.

The event saw 250 registered participants from colleges, independent research institutions

and universities across West Bengal as well as other states of India including but not limited

to Odisha, Telengana, Delhi, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Assam. Participants

ranged from college and university faculty, private educational institute faculty, research

scholars, and students.

During the first technical session, Dr. Sandeep Poddar talked about plagiarism in research

and scientific publications. The various types of plagiarism that there are and how an author

may unwittingly commit such an act was explained in detail by Dr. Poddar. He also talked

about the process of authenticating every literary work with plagiarism checkers.

During the second technical session, Dr. Priyank Patel discussed about the way to approach

scientific literature and publication, ways to access various literature databases and the

process of manuscript preparation. Dr. Patel explained in depth the current methods by which

research publications are evaluated; the criteria and norms to be followed by all authors both

technical and ethical when designing a publication. He gave practical examples of databases

useful for publication and efficient ways to extract data from them.
