


Students Feedback Question Wise Average Score

Action Taken Report

Online Feed-Back was collected from students, alumni and teachers of the college. They were analyzed and the analysis was put up on the college website. There were some issues regarding teaching-learning methods of the college, which were raised in the meeting of the college Governing Body. The G.B referred those issues to the Academic Subcommittee.

It has been observed that students were more or less satisfied with the curriculum delivery of the college. However, the institute received a score of 2.6 out of 5 regarding its efforts to promote internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities. Additionally, the percentage of teachers using ICT tools such as LCD projectors, multimedia, etc. while teaching scored 2.3. To address these issues, a comprehensive evaluation of current practices has been conducted, involving stakeholder engagement, policy review, partnership development, resource allocation, enhanced communication, and monitoring and evaluation. These actions aim to strengthen the institute's promotion of experiential learning opportunities for students and enhance their overall educational experience.

Teachers were more or less satisfied with the curriculum; though some of them faced difficulties due to connectivity issues. Their concern with the curricula was communicated to the concerned Board of Studies.
